After three years of successful cooperation between the City of Torino (Italy) and the City of Yangon (Myanmar), the European project “Environmental protection and sustainable development: building local capacities on solid waste management in Myanmar - SWM” will come to an end in February 2016.

SWM² project is holding its Final Conference in Yangon, at the Sule Shangri-La Hotel (Myanmar Ballroom) on 16th December 2015 and, starting from 9,30 a.m., welcoming an audience of around 150 participants such as National, Regional and Municipality Authorities, Representatives from the EU and Italian Foreign Affair Ministry, Local and International Stakeholders and Civil Society.

The project is led by the City of Torino (Italy) and the partners involved in the project are the Pollution Control and Cleansing Department (PCCD) of the Yangon City Development Committee (YCDC), ITHACA Association and the Italian NGO CESVI. After the opening remarks, they will illustrate the activities implemented presenting the main results, experiences and lessons learnt, visibility of the project going through the potential replication and building bridges for further and future collaboration amongst with the actors involved in Solid Waste Management/Urban Planning.

During the same week, from 14th to 18th, two final technical missions will be performed, led by experts from ITACHA and AMIAT, the company in charge of the waste collection in Torino
